Biography

Danny's practice focuses on appeals, trucking, business torts, and contracts.

Her appellate practice includes trucking litigation, medical malpractice, and complex or novel legal issues. As an appellate lawyer, she assists trial lawyers with dispositive motion briefing and preservation, provides strategic legal guidance during trial, and serves as lead counsel for post-trial motions and appellate proceedings. She regularly practices in the Eleventh Circuit, the Georgia Court of Appeals, and the Georgia Supreme Court, and she is admitted to all federal circuit courts. She co-counsels nationwide on truck accident cases in state and federal courts.

Her business litigation practice ranges from individuals and startups to Fortune 500 companies, and her experience spans industries such as retail, healthcare, transportation, technology, and dealer franchise operations.

Danny is also deeply committed to pro bono work, notably playing a role in challenging Georgia's restrictive six-week abortion ban as part of the legal team alongside attorneys from the American Civil Liberties Union, the ACLU of Georgia, the Center for Reproductive Rights, and Planned Parenthood Federation of America. She has also handled appointed § 1983 cases and worked with the Atlanta Volunteer Lawyers Foundation to defend tenants facing eviction.

In addition to her legal practice, she serves as an adjunct law professor at Georgia State University College of Law and Emory University School of Law, teaching courses in appellate practice and

Representative Matters

- Won affirmation of a \$33 million jury verdict in the Georgia Court of Appeals, successfully defeating defendants' petition for certiorari.
- Part of trial team that obtained an \$80.2 million verdict in motor vehicle collision case. Won affirmation on appeal.
- Obtained reversal in medical malpractice case based on juror bias, setting important precedent for for-cause challenges in civil cases.
- Successfully represented sexual abuse survivors in the Georgia Supreme Court, securing a unanimous ruling that opened a new avenue for lawsuits involving childhood sexual abuse by institutional leaders.
- Defeated statutory liability limitation motion to dismiss in truck accident case.
- Defeated twin Graves Amendment motions to dismiss in truck accident case.
- Successfully appealed dismissals in two interconnected wrongful death cases involving complex statute of repose issues, resulting in reversal by the Georgia Court of Appeals and denial of the defendants' petition for certiorari.
- Reversed dismissal of medical malpractice case based on statute of repose tolling during COVID-19. A unanimous Georgia Supreme Court agreed that the Judicial Emergency Order could and did toll the statute of repose. The opinion also rejected language from previous cases suggesting statutes of repose can never be tolled.
- Successfully represented a plaintiff in a medical device product liability case before the Eleventh Circuit on a complex preemption issue, reversing the dismissal and establishing significant precedent for future medical device cases.
- Prevailed in a complex medical peer review privilege discovery dispute, winning a motion to compel and successfully settling the case before trial.
- Representing Fortune 100 company in lawsuit against software vendor for massive technology outage.
- Successfully defended a former commodities company employee in a trade secret case, resulting in a favorable pre-trial settlement.
- Successfully represented a medical technology company in a theft of trade secrets and copyright infringement case, resulting in a favorable pre-trial settlement.
- Successfully represented an international medical device distributor in obtaining compensation for damage at their facility.
- Defended law firms in malpractice actions, securing summary judgment and appellate victories for clients.
